

Counselling Service

Imece provides counselling service under Advice and Counselling and Ending Harmful Practices strands.

Service provided:

- 16 sessions one-to-one VAWG counselling
- 20 sessions one-to-one Harmful Practices counselling
- on-going specialist support groups
- 6 weeks of specialist confidence building workshops

All our counselling services are for Turkish speaking women.

Prevention Strand

In this project IMECE provides training to children and young people aged between 9 and 25 for early intervention.

This service provides:

- Generic VAWG training at schools
- Specialist VAWG training at schools
- Trainings at out-of-school settings

Imece also provides training for professionals;

- Trainings at Teachers Inset Days.

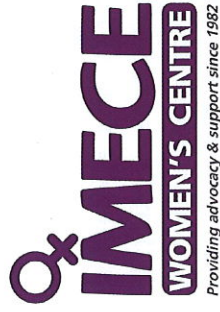

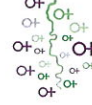
